- Refrigeration components and equipment
- Energy conservation
- Refrigeration plant and preventative maintenance

- Hotel accommodations are your responsibility.

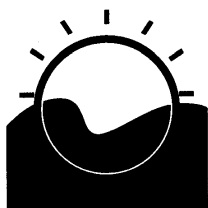
Instructor's Bio:
