SAFE ICE RESURFACER OPERATOR (SIRO) WORKSHOP

This one-day workshop introduces new and seasoned arena workers to the safe operational practices of an ice resurfacer. Created to be delivered in-house, this workshop utilizes the on-site ice resurfacer as it takes the worker through pre-flood, flood, daily and weekly safe operating practices. Health and safety legislation requires that employers provide training to all staff that operates any piece of equipment. The workshop investigates the mechanical operations of an ice resurfacer and the industry best practices to safely operate this equipment.

ICE MAINTENANCE WORKSHOP

The realities of poor operational practices do not only play out in Canadian courts, they also drain unnecessary funds from already strained arena operational budgets. This one-day workshop is designed to refresh senior staff on the importance and benefits of regular ice maintenance and introduce seasonal staff to the ice maintenance concept.

- ✓ Does your equipment suffer from Poor Maintenance Syndrome?
- ✓ Does your staff have a clear work plan for ice maintenance, which includes the use of an ice edger every day?
- ✓ Do you have hand chip areas on the ice surface and record their activities in a bound logbook?
- ✓ What piece of equipment needs to be greased every day?
- ✓ What is the recommended floodwater temperature? ...and what are the costs of having it too hot or cold?

BUILDING HOUSEKEEPING AND SANITIZATION WORKSHOP

Recreation buildings are large, have huge amounts of human traffic in all kinds of conditions and are often under staffed with little budget! Understanding the basic requirements of public health regulations as well as how to properly plan and implement a comprehensive work detail can make the task of housekeeping and sanitizing a recreation facility manageable. This one-day workshop is designed for front-line staff and as such will introduce the participants to legislative requirements and some proven techniques to safely speed all recreation cleaning jobs - with the added benefits of satisfied users and extended facility life expectancy.
